History Of The Band

The existence of the band was reported in local newspapers as early as 1887 and its character has changed throughout its approximately 125 years of existence. In the late 1880's the band performed while riding bicycles and at one time (1927) the band of 233 members was called one of the largest bands in the world. For some time it included a beginners band, a boys band and an adult band. The band has existed in its present form for over 60 years. It currently provides musical programming, entertainment and recreation to the citizens of St. Cloud and the surrounding area by presenting a series of outdoor concerts in local parks as well as performing at area special events throughout the year.
