Diversity, inclusion and equity committee (Vicki, Lucy, Tammy K, Patric)

Vicki has gotten through two of the four concerts. Demographics: Vicki is looking at mapping of the communities around Barden park and the region. City of St Cloud population about 69K. Sartell fastest growing city in region. Not all of 2020 census information is available yet. People of color: 32.3% of city of St Cloud – double of 2010. St Cloud Metro total population of color is 25%. 76% of metro is white – significant decrease from 2010. Concerts – not reaching people of color, all white. Income isn't being filled out well. Those that fill out, usually <\$50K family income. Lower to middle income. Even split male/female Age – typically 61-70 y.o. Majority of concert goers are either brought by member, or know a member. Close to home, most <5 miles. Genres: Marches, Medleys from plays/musicals most popular. Not preferred music: Contemporary, pop-rock, new composers (expected with age of attendees). Want to hear more jazz, blues, polkas. Committee to meet to discuss statistics and work on Band-Member Survey

<u>Discussion regarding commissioning a piece</u> – perhaps looking at getting a grant for specifically commissioning a piece from a diverse composer. Commissioning a piece starts about \$4000. Andy to do some more research on this.
